I havent seen the new bylaws so I cant really comment. I know you have been pushing this, but I still have strong reservations about a merger, and probably would not support it, even if participation continues to dwindle, and there is little reason to meet. As you may have heard, Jim McDonnell's influence at least on WFCCA if not the community is still out there, and Jim's wishes were very much against a merger, when he was around. Although I recognize 13 years have passed, and the world is a different place, I think there still can be a niche/role for both WFCCA and SDC, with slightly different priorities, complementing each other and joining voices when appropriate. WFCCA is never going to fit well with the Federation and maybe vice versa. Maybe 2 independent groups can have a stronger influence on the BOS et al than one. I personally would prefer that both groups retain their identities, even if certain functions could be partly or largely combined. Maybe there would be merit in having the land use committees try to meet together for awhile [preferably not on PC nights when I can never go], or alternating, or on big cases.

Maybe if you meet on not a PC night I can be there.
